It took a decade of hard work to get here, but we've made it! DUMBO is New York City's newest Historic District. Now we need to look at the relationship of our village to our immediate neighbors, Vinegar Hill and Fulton Ferry Landing. Parts of these communities are also landmark-protected, but there are gaps among us: unprotected areas that virtually invite inappropriate construction by speculative developers.

DNA has retained Paul Graziano, a well-regarded urban planning consultant, to advise us on these joint concerns. At this press conference, he will present his findings and recommendations.

Everyone who cares about preserving the character of our unique neighborhood—listed by the National Trust last year as one of "America's 11 most endangered historic places"—should attend.
