Beginning Thursday December 16, 2010 for approximately one week

Beginning Thursday December 16, 2010, and continuing through next week. Washington Street B/T Plymouth Street and Front Street will be closed to traffic. This closure is necessary to accommodate pile driving work being performed as part of NYC DDC's Water Street Project.

COMMUNITY IMPACTS:

TRAFFIC/PARKING/ACCESS

- Washington Street will be open for emergency traffic only,
- Parking on Washington Street will be restricted.

STORAGE/SAFETY/WORK AREAS:

- Contractor will maintain site safety in and around the work area and carefully store his equipment to ensure public safety. Pedestrians should keep a safe distance from the work area, equipment and stored materials.)
- The trench work, will take approximately (7) working days, depending on the ground condition, which is unknown.

NOISE/VIBRATION

- There will be noise and vibration associated with this operation, which is driving the piles under where the sewer will be placed.
- A Vibration monitoring box is located at the work site, to ensure that the vibrations are maintained in accordance within the acceptable limits
